

To be considered for the CIT program, teens will need to complete an application and go through an interview process. Applications are due by February 16. Please ask your references to submit their reference forms by February 16 as well. Interviews will be scheduled in Feb/Mar, and we will let you know our decisions by mid-March. CITs must commit to three full weeks, and we will be running two sessions: Session 1 will run from July 1–19 and Session 2 will run from July 22–August 9. If you are accepted as a CIT, the program fees are \$75 for members and \$100 for non-members. This fee will be waived for returning CITs.

## **Dear Counselor in Training Applicant,**

At the Morris Arboretum & Gardens Nature Explorers Camp we take our Counselor in Training program seriously. We want everyone to have a great camp experience, and we will train you and give you the tools to be a good leader and a camp counselor.
