# ‘Witchhazel’ is your favorite?

Witchhazel (*Hamamelidaceae*) flowers are yellow, orange or red and appear during the gray days of fall and winter. Each fragrant flower has slender petals. Can you count them? The witchhazels you see today won't have any leaves. Witchhazels are deciduous and lose their leaves in the fall like many other trees and shrubs.

## Fun Facts!

- Witchhazels are often called snapping hazels because the fruit capsules explode to release black seeds when ripe.
- The bark and leaves of witchhazels are used in herbal medicines as an astringent, a chemical that dries, tightens, and hardens body tissue. Witchhazel oil is used in after-shave and lotions to treat bruises, sunburn, and insect bites.
